

McHenry Township—A Winter Wonderland

McHenry Township Park is the place to be for WINTER FAMILY FUN!



Bundle up after a fresh snowfall and enjoy the Sledding Hill.

Be sure to follow the posted Park Rules for a safe sledding experience.

The Sledding Hill is not supervised so use at your own risk and understand that the Township is not responsible for injuries.

The park offers an obstacle free sledding run of about 300 feet that even the adults will enjoy. The new downhill path extends out into the soccer fields for maximum coasting area. Remember to keep hands, feet and clothing within the sled and hold on to the sled or the person seated in front of you.

A safety concern of '*sledders climbing the hill too close to the downhill path*' has been addressed and a dedicated area for climbing up the hill has been constructed at the east side of the hill. There now is a wide platform walkway with railings for uphill traffic to the left of the downhill path.

There should be at least 2" of snow and no grass visible. When posted, obey "SLEDDING HILL CLOSED" signs as the hill may be closed due to lack of snow cover or for other safety reasons.

The area is lighted...making it perfect for safe, after dark sledding. Day or night, it is always a good idea to wear bright colored clothing so that you are visible to other sledders.



Between the parking lot and the sledding hill is an enclosed winter shelter with tables, a grill and electricity. There are indoor restrooms and a fireplace for warming; the township provides the wood.

Dress warm, obey all posted signs and experience the thrill of sledding!
