TAX LEVY ORDINANCE
MCHENRY TOWNSHIP
ORDINANCE 110923

An ordinance levying taxes for all town purposes for McHenry Township, McHenry County, Illinois, for the tax year 2023 collectable in 2024.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of McHenry Township, McHenry County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the sum of One Million, Six Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$1,625,000) are hereby levied upon all property subject to taxation within the Township as that property is assessed and equalized, in order to meet and defray all necessary expenses and liabilities of the Township as required by statute or voted by the people in accordance with the law, for such purposes as:

GENERAL TOWN FUND

GENERAL ASSISTANCE

For the fiscal year beginning April 1, 2024, and ending March 31, 2025.

SECTION 2: That the amount levied for each object and purpose shall be as follows:

General Corporate Tax	\$1,525,000
Public Assistance Tax	100,000
TOTAL TAXES LEVIED:	\$ 1,625,000

SECTION 3: That the Town Clerk shall make and file with the County Clerk of said County of McHenry, on or before the last Tuesday of December, a duly certified copy of this ordinance.


SECTION 4: That if any section, subdivision, or sentence of this ordinance shall for any reason be held invalid or to be unconstitutional, such finding shall not effect the validity of the remaining portion of this ordinance.

SECTION 5: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its adoption, as provided by law.


