Supervisor Adams called the meeting to order in the McHenry Township Hall at the published and posted time of 1:00 pm, with the Pledge of Allegiance.

**Roll call:** Anderson here, Adams here, Rakestraw here, Verr here. Wojewski here.  
Also attending the meeting was Attorney Militello, Clerk Aylward, and Accounting Manager Macrito, and 17 Public and call in.

**Public Comment -**

Trustee Anderson made a motion to change the language on the Proposition of Resolution 112006B to be filed with the McHenry County Clerk and Board on July 6, 2020, second by Trustee Rakestraw.

**Discussion Ensued** – The attorney addressed the language change and the Resolution number. Trustee Wojewski stated that the new resolution is the same as the resolution voted on in March. In addition, the County Clerk Mr. Tirio stated that it can't be put on the ballot again for 23 months. Trustee Verr stated that Mr. Wojewski is wrong and should read the statue and that Mr. Tirio is wrong and that it is not part of the law to not have the resolution on the ballot again. The Attorney addressed that there is no difference in the wording that the only difference is the date of dissolution.
