TAX LEVY ORDINANCE
MCHENRY TOWNSHIP
ORDINANCE 120822

An ordinance levying taxes for all town purposes for McHenry Township, McHenry County, Illinois, for the tax year 2022 collectable in 2023.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of McHenry Township, McHenry County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the sum of One Million, Five Hundred Fourteen Thousand, Five Hundred Sixteen Dollars (\$1,514,516) are hereby levied upon all property subject to taxation within the Township as that property is assessed and equalized, in order to meet and defray all necessary expenses and liabilities of the Township as required by statute or voted by the people in accordance with the law, for such purposes as:

For the fiscal year beginning April 1, 2023, and ending March 31, 2024.

SECTION 2: That the amount levied for each object and purpose shall be as follows:







**TRUTH IN TAXATION CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE
MCHENRY TOWNSHIP
(35 ILCS 200/18-90)**

I, the undersigned, hereby certify that I am the presiding officer of McHenry Township, and as such presiding officer I certify that the levy ordinance, a copy of which is attached, was adopted pursuant to, and in all respects in compliance with the provisions of Section 18-60 through 18-85 of the Truth in Taxation Law.

The taxing district's aggregate levy does not exceed a 5% increase over the prior year's extension. Therefore, a notice and a hearing was not necessary. The provisions of Section of Section 18-60 through 18-85 of the Truth in Taxation Law are not applicable and have been complied with to the 2022 levy ordinance.
